CATEGORY	WIND SPEED/Knots (mph)
1	Winds of 64-82 knots (74-95 mph)
2	Winds of 83-95 knots (96-110 mph)
3	Winds of 96-113 knots (111-130 mph)
4	Winds of 114-135 knots (131-155 mph)
5	Winds of 135 knots (greater than 155 mph)
