

Supply List for Painting Classes by Davilla Harding

The key to vibrant, translucent watercolor paintings is to start with the finest quality materials possible; especially paints, paper, and brushes. The most beautiful watercolor paintings are created by using transparent artist quality watercolors.

Materials to be supplied by the **participant**: (Supplies 1-6 are all available in the craft store.)

1. 3 watercolor brushes: Size 16, size 10 and size 3 (or 2)
2. 1 kneaded eraser (jumbo if possible)
3. Masking fluid – Pebeo drawing gum (45 ml)
4. 1 rubber cement pick up
5. Palette of your choice – Small (with at least 10 - 12 slots for paints)
6. 1 mechanical pencil
7. Roll of paper towels
8. 2 large, inexpensive plastic containers for water (quart-size or larger) – Rubber Maid, etc.

Materials to be supplied by the **instructor**:

1. 1 half sheet of 300 lb cold press watercolor paper with drawing of subject provided.
(Please bring \$8.50 to reimburse instructor for the watercolor paper...Mahalo!)
2. Watercolor paints. Instructor will supply paints, or you may bring your own. We will be using mostly primary colors.
