CYP is currently operating in Level CYP-2

- Childcare access limited to mission essential/critical personnel who cannot execute job function via telework/self-care for own children
- 2 centers open (Center Drive CDC and Hickam School Age)
- Health screenings are taking place before entering centers
- Face Coverings are required to be worn while in the centers (except children)
- CYP is practicing social distancing in open centers with low classroom numbers
