Glass Sun Catchers (or Ornaments and Sun Catchers) with Jessica FitzGerald

The perfect course to help use up extra scrap glass! This quick fun class will cover different fusing methods and fun creative ways to use up scrap glass. Students will get to utilize their extra glass to make bright beautiful sun catchers and ornaments to hang in the window or give as gifts. Glass experience required.

This class is designed to help students use up their leftover sheet glass in a fun and creative way. In this regard I will be working with students to help them use up their own specific glass scraps, rather than having already set projects. This means that there is no need to purchase new glass to take full advantage of the class! However, if you would like more glass for the specific project you have in mind the ceramic studio will be open until 5pm, so getting to class a little early will allow you time to pick-up some new materials if that's something you feel you need. I will also have a few general project ideas for people to use as jumping off places for their individualized projects if they so desire.
