





You will be able to determine if an item is ready for pick up by looking at the Position Number.

In this example, Position 3 means you are the third person in line for this item.



Position 1 can mean two different things. It can mean the item is ready for pick up and it can mean you're next in line to get the item. To determine which one applies to your item, select the title.
