- Coordination between military and civilian agencies for enhanced personnel support.
- Medical, educational, and community support services
- Access to Information & Referral resources tailored to your family's needs.


This month's topic: Maximizing TRICARE Benefits for Exceptional Families-Unlocking TRICARE ECHO: Extra Support for Exceptional Families

Did you know your family may be eligible for more than standard TRICARE benefits? The Extended Care Health Option (ECHO) is designed to provide additional services for family members with qualifying special needs.

What Does ECHO Cover?

ECHO helps with: In-home medical services, respite care for primary caregivers, durable medical equipment (like wheelchairs or communication devices), special education services, applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) for autism spectrum disorders, and more? **To be eligible for ECHO:** Your family member must be enrolled in the EFMP. They must have a qualifying condition (developmental, physical, or mental). You must be enrolled in TRICARE Prime, Select, or TRICARE Overseas Program.

Respite Care

As a parent, caregiver, or guardian of an individual with special needs, it is crucial to prioritize self-care in order to maintain your own well-being. Respite care offers short-term relief for primary caregivers and provides flexible care options. Services may be delivered in various settings, including the home, specialized facilities, or adult day centers. Additional options may include schools, camps, or through volunteer organizations.

Eligible families enrolled in the Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) can access respite care services for children through **Child Care Aware.**

For **adults with special needs**, respite care may be available through state programs or nonprofit organizations. Payment assistance options may include the Tricare Extended Health Care Option (ECHO) or Medicaid Waivers, depending on eligibility.




