## POLICIES

One account is created for each family with the sponsor being responsible for all material borrowed. You will be issued a library card and/or you can use your government ID. Failure to follow library policies can result in suspension of library use. It is a privilege, not a right to use the library.

- OPAC** | Locate material, access your account; place holds, renew material, etc.
- BORROWING INFORMATION** | A hold can be placed on material from the OPAC or by completing a Library Reserve Request form. Learn more at <https://jbphh.greatlifehawaii.com/rec/library>. Information section, "Requests/Holds" tab.
- LOAN PERIODS** | DVD, video game/console/accessory: One week. Everything else: Three weeks.
- ITEM LIMITS** | NO LIMIT ON BOOKS • 10 audiobooks • 10 DVDs • 6 video game accessories  
• 3 video games • 3 study guides (CD/DVD/iPOD) • 3 STEM Kits • 1 video game console  
• 1 Sewing Machine • 1 Board Game
- RENEWALS** | Most material can be renewed two times by e-mail, in person, over the phone, or on the OPAC provided the patron does not have overdue material or the item is not on hold for another patron.
- OVERDUE MATERIAL** | Borrowing privileges may be suspended when material is overdue. This suspension applies to everyone on the account and may be removed once all material is returned or a suitable replacement is provided. To help reduce overdue material, please respond to notices and/or manage due dates on the OPAC — select My Checkouts to renew material.
