# IS YOUR CHILD HEADING TO KINDERGARTEN?

## IF SO, THIS INFORMATION IS FOR YOU!



### REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

Requirements are completed prior to enrollment:

- A physical examination
- Up-to-date immunizations
- A current TB Test/TB Screening

Documents you will need:

- Child's Birth Certificate
- Proof of current address
- Legal documents, as needed (power attorney, custody papers, etc.)
- Military orders (including housing orders)

### PREPARING FOR THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL:

- Set aside your child's clothes and school bag the night before
- Ensure he/she has a good rest for the two nights prior to the first day of school
- Wake up early to avoid rushing
- Feed your child a nutritious breakfast
- Explain after school care and pick up meeting points
- Be positive and show enthusiasm
- Don't forget your camera!
- Give your child a reassuring hug and kiss and keep your good-bye short
- Enjoy this new chapter in your child's life and good luck in Kindergarten!

### PARENT INVOLVEMENT OPPORTUNITIES:

- Participate in the Parent Teacher Organization (PTO)
- Join and attend School Community Council meetings
- Volunteer in your child's classroom and chaperone field trips
- Communicate with and assist the Parent Community Networking Coordinator (PCNC)
- Attend your child's Parent-Teacher Conferences
- Ensure your child is successful in school by making sure that homework assignments are completed, he/she is on-time and ready to learn
- Communicate regularly with your child's teacher

### TEMPORARY LODGING

While staying in temporary housing, there are designated schools for your child to attend until your family receives permanent housing. Your child will be assigned to a school based on the location of your temporary housing. If you move to a permanent house that is located in a different district than your temporary lodging, your child will be assigned to a different school. The temporary schools do not always have enough space to accommodate temporary students all year long. Geographic Exceptions (G.Es) to attend a different school are rarely granted.

## **PERMANENT CHANGE OF STATION(PCS) FAQ's**

- Hawaii DOE is the only statewide school system (district) in the US
- You must attend the school that is zoned for your physical address (while in lodging and after you get a permanent house). Possibility of attending 2 different schools.
- Schools start the first week of August on the 4th.
- Hand carry all important school records to include but not limited to report cards, test scores, etc.
- Make sure IEP/504 Plan is current, you may want to request a transitional IEP/504 Plan before leaving current school
- Connect with the receiving installation School Liaison Officer

**Online Registration for Students NEW\* to the Hawai'i State Department of Education (HIDOE) for the School Year 2020-2021**

You will need to submit a separate application for each school to which you are applying. To complete the online registration for your child, you will need to upload the following mandatory documents. If you are unable to upload any of the mandatory documents, you **cannot** use this method to enroll your child. Please contact your school for other options to enroll.

- A valid photo ID of the parent/guardian involving the child (e.g., driver's license, passport, state ID)
- Completed Enrollment Form (SEI 5240) for each child you are enrolling. Download form (202)
- Student birth certificate. If your child is from a foreign country, the student transport or student visa is acceptable.
- Proof of address.

\*New students are children who will be attending a HIDOE school for the first time during school year 2020-21 (e.g., entering kindergarten, transferring from a private school or out-of-state school).

Email Address Only if you have had a child that currently or previously attended a Hawai'i DOE school, check the box "Previously Attended this District". This will alert the school that your information exists in the student information system. Enter the letters or numbers that appear in the CAPTCHA box in the field provided. Click the "Begin Registration" button.
