Air Force Moving Checklist

120 Days (Four months)

- Pets need to be prepared for relocation at least 120 days prior to your arrival. All pets entering Hawaii may be eligible for a 30-day, 5-day, or direct release from the airport if requirements are met. Contact the Animal Quarantine Branch at (808) 483-7151 or visit their website at http://www.hawaii.gov/hdoa/ai/aqs/info
- □ The Army MWR Boarding Kennel has limited spaces available. Call 808-368-3456 for further information.
- □ Inventory and take photos of your possessions. *Be advised that houses on- and off-base in Hawaii are relatively smaller in comparison to those found on the mainland*. Plan on storing your big appliances (refrigerators, washers and dryers) while in Hawaii. Appliances will be provided by the Furnishing Management Office (DSN 315-448-0300).
- □ Secure on-base billeting as soon as possible by calling DSN 315-448-5974/5975. If billeting is unavailable, secure a non-availability letter prior to making a hotel reservation.
- □ Start researching your new community by visiting the Military One Source website at www.militaryinstallations.dod.mil/ www.militaryonesource.com
- □ Start researching Hawaii schools. There are five main feeder schools servicing our Hickam children. Two elementary schools (*Mokulele and Hickam*) are located on Hickam and one (Nimitz) is adjacent to base housing just outside the gate. *Aliamanu Middle* and *Radford High Schools* are located about ten minutes from the installation. 60 Days (Two months)

- □ Visit your Air Force Aid Society (AFAS) to obtain a Childcare for PCS certificate. This certificate provides you with 20 hours of free childcare per child with a licensed family child care provider.
- □ Consult with your legal office to obtain necessary powers of attorney.
- □ If you have not received a sponsor packet nor been contacted by your sponsor, contact your "gaining" orderly room.
- □ Upon receipt of orders, go to <u>www.militarychildcare.com</u> to get on the Family Child Care waitlist.
- □ For single airmen (E-1 to E-3), contact your "gaining" orderly room to obtain dormitory information. If you are unable to contact your orderly room, contact the Unaccompanied Dorm Manager at DSN 315-448-2007.
- □ If you are planning on living off-base, begin your research by visiting the Housing Services Office website at <u>http://www.homes.mil</u>, <u>http://www.hicentral.com</u>, and <u>https://www.ahrn.com/</u> (No Longer DoD funded)

45 days

30 days (One month)

- □ If you plan on sending your vehicle to Hawaii, ensure that all required maintenance has been completed. Access <u>https://www.whereismypov.com</u> or <u>https://www.pcsmypov.com</u> to track the shipment of your vehicle.
- □ Minimum car rental age is 21. Contact your sponsor regarding transportation options.
- □ Contact your insurance company concerning vehicles, home and household goods. Check with your current insurance company on coverage in Hawaii.
- □ Arrange to pick up your child's school records or obtain the proper procedures for sending records to their new school. Hawaii State Law requires all students to meet certain examination and immunization requirements. You must present a completed health record form to the school.
