Hawaiian Koa Rocking Chair

- 25 board feet of 2 inch Koa or Mango, 5 board feet of 1 inch Koa or Mango (please email us to receive the instructor's email for list of wood vendors)
- Domino tenons 10mm x 24mm x 50mm (6 each)
- Dowelpins 3/9" x 2" (35 each) spiral or fluted cut
- Water based wood finish 1 quart (i.e. Emtech 6000 or solvent based Deft or Watco)
- Wood finish 1 quart (Danish oil, Natural Deft or Watco)
- Sand paper 60G, 80G, 120G, and 220G
- Glue (Aliphatic resin such as Titebon 1, 2 or 3)
